Duties and Functions:

Teach a variety of digital imaging, audio recording and video production courses. Instructors will be expected to take an active role in student advising, curriculum enhancement and serve as a positive role model for educational enrichment. During the course of our three week sessions, HCDI collectively seeks to systematically encourage students to pursue further opportunities for professional development via classroom style instruction and field trips. Instructors must be able to teach day and early afternoon classes, as well as be comfortable to traveling off-site to pre-screened field trip locations. Must be able to incorporate technology routinely in instructional curriculum and be able to communicate effectively orally and in writing and to work collaboratively.

It is essential that candidates chosen for hire exhibit an exceptional level of sensitivity to, and respect for the diverse academic, socio-economic, ethnic, religious, and cultural backgrounds, disability, and sexual orientation of this programs participants.

Educational Background:

Bachelor's degree with a concentration in media studies (preferred but not required contingent upon previous occupational experience)

Desired: Master's degree in the field, with experience teaching in an urban setting.

Experience with video production, audio production or new digital media such as digital video and audio.
